Our Club foundation meeting was held at the Mosman Town Hall on **12 June 1924**. Our **Centenary** is next year.

Let us start Celebrating with a bit of History.

Mosman Croquet Club's foundation meeting was held at the Mosman Town Hall on 12 June 1924. The mayor reported that a local women's croquet club had been formed and desired two lawns on Rawson Park. The cost would be £500 or £625 if constructed separately. The Club would pay £350 with Council to provide the balance. The club would have a membership of 80 members, and would have a President, two Vice-Presidents, a Treasurer, Secretary and 6 members of committee.



Mrs Spring was elected president, Mrs Burrows and Mrs Fraser-Clark, Vice-Presidents, Mrs Garland, Treasurer, Mrs Simpson, Hon Secretary, and Mrs Samuels, Mrs Wines, Mrs Dickson, Mrs Fallack, Mrs King and Mrs Ardice Thomas were elected to the Committee.

A meeting on 14 September 1924 decided that the *club affiliate with the Croquet Association of NSW* and that the Club colours would be pale and dark blue.
