HELLOoooo 100 years Coming Up

Episode 4: World War II and after

From 1944 money was continuously raised for the War effort, eg the Red Cross Mosman section. In 1944 Mrs F Clark donated a cup for B. players (level play) to be held perpetually at the Club. Entrance fee was 2/- per week, winner and runner-up to receive a war-saving certificate. Minutes of 4 July report the club has improved vastly in its full membership.

Minutes 1945 express sympathy in the loss of sons of members. On 4 March 1946 a letter was received appealing for the Club's assistance in the Food for Britain appeal. A Gala Day was held plus a box placed for donations with a sum raised of €8/2/6. A letter of thanks was received from Mosman Council.

In 1948 Mrs Holdworth brought forward a proposition regarding the urgent need for Parcels for Britain and it was decided to give cash donations so that parcels could get to Britain by Xmas. The meeting of 3 March 1948 reports a new member (associate) by the name of Colonel Saalfeld along with the purchase of 4 doz glass cups and saucers and the rough state of the lane way approaching the lawns – the secretary to write to the Council. In the Minutes of 13 July it is interesting that Mrs Coward represented the Mosman Club as delegate at the Annual Meeting held at Anthony Horderns on 3 August. At that time the telephone number of NSW Croquet Association was JA 8274 and that the Association lawns at Cammeray were open for hire on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Friday. One lawn 10/- per day.

The minutes of **7 September 1948** reveal an increase in membership and that Mrs Osborne of Manly and Colonel Saalfeld have joined as members with Mrs Gilbert as an associate member "and in all probability Major and Mrs Tingey will also be joining. Major Tingey is an outstanding player and would be a great acquisition in the club".

On 5 October the minutes report a very successful Gala Day, with later minutes reporting that the dairy milk container was stolen after the Social Day.......
